JOINT RESOLUTION

December 30, 1963 [S. J. Res. 113]

To authorize the President to issue annually a proclamation designating the first week in March of each year as "Save Your Vision Week".

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the President of the United States is authorized and requested to issue annually a proclamation designating the first week in March of each year as "Save mation, authori-Your Vision Week", and inviting the Governors and mayors of State zation. and local governments of the United States to issue similar proclamations. The President is further requested to consider including in such proclamation an invitation calling upon the press, radio, television, and other communications media, the health care professions and all other agencies and individuals concerned with programs for the improvement of vision to unite during such week in public activities to impress upon the people of the United States the importance of vision to their own welfare and that of our country, and to urge their support of programs to improve and protect the vision of Americans.
