ployee engaged in personnel work in excess of the number that would be provided by a ratio of one such employee to one hundred and thirtyfive, or a part thereof, full-time, part-time, and intermittent employees of the corporation or agency concerned: *Provided*, That for purposes of this section employees shall be considered as engaged in personnel work if they spend half-time or more in personnel administration consisting of direction and administration of the personnel program; employment, placement, and separation; job evaluation and classification; employee relations and services; wage administration; and processing, recording, and reporting.

Sec. 303. Appropriations and funds available for the administrative expenses of the Department of Housing and Urban Development shall be available in the current fiscal year for purchase of uniforms, or allowances therefor, as authorized by law (5 U.S.C. 5901; 80 Stat. 299); hire of passenger motor vehicles; and services as authorized by 5

U.S.C. 3109.

SEC. 304. Funds made available for the Department of Housing Legal and ing services, and Urban Development under title II of this Act shall be available, without regard to the limitations on administrative expenses, for legal services on a contract or fee basis, and for utilizing and making payment for services and facilities of Federal National Mortgage Association, Federal Reserve banks or any member thereof, Federal homeloan banks, and any insured bank within the meaning of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation Act, as amended (12 U.S.C. 1811-1831).

Sec. 305 None of the funds provided herein shall be used to pay any recipient of a grant for the conduct of a research project an amount

equal to as much as the entire cost of such project.

Sec. 306. No part of any appropriation contained in this Act shall remain available for obligation beyond the current fiscal year unless expressly so provided herein.

This Act may be cited as the "Independent Offices and Department

of Housing and Urban Development Appropriation Act, 1968".

Short title.

Public Law 90-122

AN ACT

To authorize the Secretaries concerned to direct the initiation of allotments of the pay and allowances of certain members of the Armed Forces for the purpose of making deposits under section 1035 of title 10, United States Code.

November 3, 1967 [H. R. 4772]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That section 1035 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

"(e) The Secretary concerned, or his designee, may in the interest of a member who is in a missing status (as defined in section 551(2)) of title 37) or his dependents, initiate, stop, modify, and change allotments, and authorize a withdrawal of deposits, made under this section, even though the member had an opportunity to deposit amounts under this section and elected not to do so. Interest may be computed from the day the member entered a missing status, or September 1, 1966, whichever is later."

Sec. 2. This Act becomes effective as of September 1, 1966.
