# Public Law 95–204 95th Congress

# An Act

To amend title 38 of the United States Code to increase the rates of disability and death pension and to increase the rates of dependency and indemnity compensation for parents, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That this Act be cited as the "Veterans and Survivors Pension Adjustment Act of 1977".

### TITLE I-VETERANS' AND SURVIVORS' PENSIONS

SEC. 101. Section 521 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by— (1) amending the table in subsection (b) (1) to read as follows:

"SEC. 4. The income limitations governing payment of pension under the first sentence of section 9(b) of the Veterans' Pension Act of 1959 hereafter shall be \$3,300 and \$4,760 instead of \$3,100 and 38 USC 521 note. \$4,460, respectively.".

# TITLE II-DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COMPENSATION FOR PARENTS

SEC. 201. Section 415 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by-(1) amending the table in subsection (b) (1) to read as follows:
