Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That (a) section 731(e) of title 31, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by striking out "title 5," and inserting in lieu thereof "title 5," and inserti

5 at rates not in excess of the maximum daily rate for GS-18 under section 5332 of such title,"; and

(2) in paragraph (1), by striking out "10" and inserting in lieu thereof "15"

(b) Section 732(c)(4) of title 31, United States Code, is amended by

striking out "100" and inserting in lieu thereof "119".

(c) Section 733(c) of title 31, United States Code, is amended by

inserting "(e)(1)," after "(d),".

SEC. 2. The amendments made by this Act shall take effect beginning on October 1, 1984.
